Why Kenya?

Eye watering facts about the areas of Kenya where CRK-UK work*:

- Absolute poverty = 51%
- Children under 18yrs = 49%, under 5 = 18%
- Stunting (malnutrition) in children = 29.2%
- Over 300,000 street children

There is no help available, no safety net for children or families in difficulty, no children's allowance, no state benefits. No support network. Here rural unemployment is as high as 80%. Even though society still depends on a strong family unit, endemic poverty and high rates of morbidity often lead to family breakdown.

Children speak with their feet.

Every day children, some as young as 3, arrive on the streets of towns throughout Kenya. Alone and with no responsible adult care or guidance they are among the most vulnerable people on earth.

Once in town these newcomers are quickly drawn into a subculture where the main aim is survival by whatever means. Thus begins a process of hardening, dehumanisation and corruption that is often irreversible, frequently abusive and can end in early death.

Our Ethos

Every child deserves a family. A family that offers love and protection, and that nurtures development and inclusion

How we help

CRK-UK works directly with Kenyan partners to protect vulnerable children in the short term, while strengthening and empowering families. This enables them to better care for their own children.

The strategies used are simple, effective and with sustainable outcomes:

1. Through outreach and/or referral:
 - Identify and offer support to vulnerable children
2. Drop-in Centre:
 - Provide day care, counselling and education to children remaining on the streets.
 - Initial family location/identification
3. Rescue Centre:
 - 24/7 transitional residential care
 - Family identification
 - Support families enabling reunification
4. Family/Youth empowerment:
 - Training and education
 - Small business & agricultural startup grants
5. Residential Centre:
 - Longer term care for those who need it
 - Enrolment in school
 - Family identification
6. Advocacy & Awareness:
 - Child protection at community level
 - Pre-empt child separation

Each year our partners reach out to hundreds of children and families enabling reunification, preventing abuse and ensuring children's rights.
